### **Pre-College Summer Scholarships for Ivy League Study**

Scholarship dollars are available for female sophomores and juniors who would like to participate in a summer pre-college program at an elite university.

### **PRATT Pre-College Program**

Experience college level study at Pratt in art, design, architecture, creative writing or critical & visual studies. The program consists of four classes, lectures, cultural and social events.

Students can earn 4 college credits.

**Dates:** July 6 – July 30

**Eligibility:** 16 years of age by 6/30/2010, self-motivated and responsible

**Application Deadline:** 3/15/2010

**Cost:** ~ \$2200 (Scholarships are available)

### **Wright State University Pre-College Program**

Each program is a one-week residential program offered for students entering grades 10-11-12. Institutes are offered in Anatomy and Physiology, Archeology, Communications, Creative Writing, Engineering, Forensic Science, Law, Nursing, Performance Theatre, Poetry, Science and Technology.

**Dates:** varies (6/20 – 7/23)

**Eligibility:** students entering grades 10,11, or 12

**Application Deadline:** 2 weeks prior to the program start

**Cost:** ~ \$600

### **Baldwin Wallace So You Want to Be Program**

Students can investigate careers in Writing, Biotechnology, International Business, Entrepreneurship, Engineering or Sports Management. Each program offers classes, hands-on experience in a college setting and off-site visits in the professional field.

**Dates:** varies (6/13 – 7/30)

**Eligibility:** students entering grades 9 or 10, top 25% of the class

**Application Deadline:** March 15, 2010

**Cost:** ~800

### **The Jonathan R Reynolds Young Writers Workshop**

This 8-day workshop is designed as an opportunity to develop the student's talents and visions as a beginning poet or writer.

**Miami University *B the Change (U Wish 2 C) 2010*** is an intensive two-week long program (July 12-23) that focuses on civic engagement through youth empowerment, social responsibility, and community service work.

**Miami University Academy of Game Design**

The program is two exciting weeks building a state of the art 3D environment and one or more characters. Participants will use standard industry tools like Maya, 3ds Max, Zbrush and the Unreal Engine.

**Miami University Jazz Camp for Instrumentalists**
