

Gifted Testing Schedule 2010-2011

General Testing Information

Every student is given two opportunities for testing during the school year, in January and May. Students new to the Edgewood City School District may request testing at the beginning of the school year. The results of the test determine service for the following school year.

To request testing for gifted identification, print the referral form found on Edgewood's Gifted Education webpage. You may send the form to the gifted services office or return it to school with your child. This form includes a required section granting permission to test your child.

Referrals for testing are due one week prior to the beginning of testing.

Grades K-2

The OLSAT is given for identification as superior cognitive ability.

January 24th – 28th

May 16th – 20th

Grades 3 and 6

All students in Grades 3 and 6 take the CogAT for identification as superior cognitive ability.

October 25th – 29th

Grades 3 – 11

Students in grades 3 through 11 may be referred for the ITBS for identification in specific subject areas (Math, Language Arts, Social Studies, Science). They may also be referred for the CogAT for identification as superior cognitive ability.

January 24th – 28th

May 16th – 20th

Visual and Performing Arts Grades 3 - 11

Gifted identification in the visual and performing arts requires a performance or portfolio to be assessed. Referrals may be made using the referral form referenced above.

Performance Day for Performing Arts: March 3rd

Portfolio Day for Visual Arts: May 12th
