

# POST SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS PROGRAM



## What is it?

The Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program allows students to take college classes while they are in high school. The courses count for credit in both places.



## What is the cost?

Under Option B of this program there is no cost to the student. The parents of the student are responsible for transportation. The student may have to buy special equipment such as a calculator.

## What are the requirements of the program?

The requirements for the program vary at the area universities. Most of our students participate at Miami University. At this time, Miami University's regional campuses require that high school students have a 3.25 G.P.A. and completion of college preparatory credits. Ninth and tenth grade participants must also show superior academic performance and provide a letter of recommendation from an Edgewood teacher in the subject area of the college class they wish to take. MUM requires a 21 composite on the ACT. Any student considering the Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program at MUM or Oxford needs to take the ACT. It is best to take the ACT by February 6 so that you have your score before the application deadline. The **deadline** for signing up for this ACT is **January 5, 2010**. ## Required Meeting

Parents are required to attend a meeting that reviews the program in detail including the advantages and disadvantages. Parents and students will have to sign a form that they attended this session and accept the responsibilities of the program. The required meeting will take place on **February 11 at 5:30 P.M.** in the high school lecture room.
