

POST SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS PROGRAM 2012-2013



What is it?

The Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program allows students to take college classes while they are in high school. The courses count for credit in both places.



What is the cost?

Under Option B of this program there is no cost to the student. The parents of the student are responsible for transportation. The student may have to buy special equipment such as a calculator.

What are the requirements of the program?

The requirements for the program vary at the area universities. Most of our students participate at Miami University. At this time, Miami University's regional campuses require that high school students have a 3.25 G.P.A. and completion of college preparatory credits. Ninth and tenth grade participants must also show superior academic performance and provide a letter of recommendation from an Edgewood teacher in the subject area of the college class they wish to take. Any student considering the Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program at Oxford must have a 3.5 GPA and needs to take the ACT. It is best to take the ACT by February 11 so that you have your score before the application is due. The **deadline** for signing up for this ACT is **January 13, 2012**. Required Meeting

Parents are required to attend a meeting that reviews the program in detail including the advantages and disadvantages. Parents and students will have to sign a form that they attended this session and accept the responsibilities of the program. The required meeting will take place on **Feb. 16 at 5:30 P.M.** in the high school lecture room.



How do I sign up?

If you decide that this program is for you and you meet the criteria, there is a form that you need to complete in the Student Services office at the high school. **Sign up Deadline is March 30.**
